

Off-Campus Learning Framework

Fall Semester 2020

Parents have the choice to opt out of on-campus instruction and instead participate in an off-campus learning alongside their child. This option will look different than the distance learning model used last spring. The off-campus learning experience will include, but is not limited to, the below framework. Please read through the details before making your commitment for the quarter.

What will off-campus learning look like?

- Most whole-group lessons will be available to watch live stream at designated times (excluding some electives).
- Spanish classes PK-5th will be available for live steam viewing.
- Art class will be available for live steam viewing pending project work K-7th.
- Live stream lessons for PK-2 will be shared on SeeSaw.
- Live stream lessons 3rd-7th will be shared on Google Classroom.
- Graded work and submission requirements will be determined by each individual classroom teacher and will vary by grade level.

PK-Kindergarten

- Live steam viewing of morning meeting and whole-group lessons is encouraged.
- Teachers will provide a Toolkit for parents to implement at home, to include lists of sensory activities and thematic center resources.
- If available, physical manipulatives may be provided to support learning.
- Additional literacy and math practice will be provided either digitally or for pick up.

1st-5th Grade

- Literacy resources will be provided to parents to implement at home, to include read-aloud book lists, Workshop Units of Study resources, and spelling word work.
- Everyday Math and Studies Weekly lessons (social studies and science) are available online. Teachers may provide additional lesson plans and (lists of) hands-on manipulatives to support learning if available and/or necessary.

Middle School Grades

- Attendance will be taken during all Live Steam lessons.
- Workshop Units of Study resources will be shared with parents digitally.
- New STEM and Social Studies curriculum available online, with work assigned through program platforms by teachers.
- World Language classes are completed online.
- Live steam Art and Mad Science classes will vary pending project work.
- All work submission will be through Google Classroom and have daily due dates.
